Heo Young-ho completed all seven continents and the three poles, his last ascent being Vinson Massif in December 1995. If you need data on his history, I can contact the Heo Young-ho Foundation and send you the supporting documentation. Please let me know if you need it.

Heo Young-ho has climbed almost all seven continents twice.

He has also climbed Mount Everest six times.
